#### **New Staff**

### School Gate Safety

The whole community was shocked by the accident at the school gates which resulted in a pupil from Winchburgh Primary School being injured. Ideas for how to improve the congestion at the school gate have been discussed at the Parent Council and also with representatives from the Community Council as well as West Lothian Council and the Elected Members for the Winchburgh Area.

One of the problems for Holy Family is congestion at the front door at the end of the school day as there are a large number of parents and carers in one, small area and some people have been stepping into the road to be able to pass groups standing on the path.

After consultation with Winchburgh Primary, we will now dismiss our children from the playground at the North side of the school. The gates at the Nursery entrance will open at **3pm** to allow Holy Family parents and carers to enter the playground at that end of the building to wait for the children to be dismissed out of the doors at the back of the school.

Access to the playground will close at **3:30pm** to allow the nursery children to utilise the play area again. By that time, all of our families will need to have cleared the playground area.

This new plan should move our families away from the narrow path at the front of the building to a safer area within the school grounds. The new arrangement will start on Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> of January.

### **New School Building**

Architects working on a design for our new school are in the very early stages of creating a plan. There will be opportunities for the school community to contribute their ideas to the planning process and to see the design as it develops. James Cameron (Head of Service) is the contact person at the Civic Centre for the design of the new school.
